



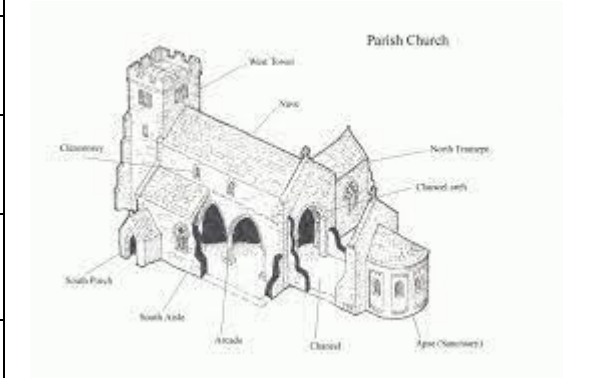
# RE - THOUGHTFULNESS



## Vocabulary

<b>Religion</b>	A particular system of faith and worship
<b>Muslim</b>	A follower of the religion of Islam.
<b>Islam</b>	The religion of the Muslims
<b>Mosque</b>	A Muslim place of worship.
<b>Qur'an</b>	The Islamic sacred book, believed to be the word of God as dictated to Muhammad by the archangel Gabriel and written down in Arabic.
<b>Prophet</b>	A person regarded as an inspired teacher or proclaimer of the will of God.
<b>Christian</b>	A person who has received Christian baptism or is a believer in Christianity.
<b>Church</b>	A building used for public Christian worship.
<b>Cathedral</b>	The principal church of a diocese, with which the bishop is officially associated.
<b>Salah</b>	Second pillar of Islam
<b>Liturgy</b>	A form or formulary according to which public religious worship, especially Christian worship, is conducted.
<b>Values</b>	A principle or standard about what is important in one's life.

## Sticky knowledge

Church is a public place of worship, usually for people of the Christian religion. Some Christian denominations, or groups, also have buildings called cathedrals
Mosque buildings have large open spaces inside, with mats or carpets covering the floor. Men perform prayer on these mats, under the guidance of an Imām, who is a worship leader in the Muslim community.
Jesus gave us The Lord's Prayer to let us know that God wants us to talk to Him each day, through prayer, and to share what's on our hearts
The second Pillar of Islam is to worship God five times a day — at dawn, noon, mid-afternoon, sunset, and nightfall
In Muslim prayer the believer washes according to a particular ritual and prostrates himself or herself on the ground in the direction of Mecca, while reciting certain phrases.
Wisdom is not just knowledge. It's knowing how to make good choices based on learning and experiences.
