- Provide an interesting and exciting curriculum that will inspire children.
- Monitor and review our teaching to ensure that every child makes maximum progress.
- Set activities and work that is appropriate to each child's abilities.
- Give pupils clear feedback about their learning and progress.
- Encourage and recognise good attendance and punctuality.
- Encourage and celebrate high standards of behaviour.
- Support children who face difficulties / barriers to their learning.
- Develop your child's independence and confidence.
- Follow national and local guidance to ensure a safe environment (e.g. Covid protective measures).



We expect our **PARENTS & CARERS** to:

- Support the aims and values of the school.
- Encourage my child to follow the school rules and try hard at all they do.
- Ensure that my child attends school regularly and on time; inform the school if my child is absent.
- Tell the school of any problems or issues (e.g. that might affect my child at school).
- Follow the school '*Parent Code of Conduct*'.
- Respect the confidentiality of school issues, especially regarding pupils and families at school.
- Read all school correspondence (e.g. letters, emails, text messages) and respond as appropriate.
- Take an interest in my child's learning and progress; support my child with their homework.
- Attend Parent Consultations & meetings that have been organised by school.
- Make sure my child has the appropriate equipment and school uniform.
- Have regard for the safety of others, including driving and parking safely near school.
- Follow school procedures to ensure the school site is safe (e.g. by following school start / end of day routines and following current covid guidelines).

We expect our **PUPILS** to:

- ✓ Follow our Rainbow Rules and school values.
- ✓ Show respect and care for other people.
- ✓ Tell an adult at school if I have any worries or problems about school.
- ✓ Listen to my teacher and other adults at school.
- ✓ Have a positive attitude to lessons and learning; try hard at everything I do.
- ✓ Look after school equipment, the school building and school grounds.
- ✓ Make the most of every opportunity that school offers.
- ✓ Keep myself safe and think about the safety of others.
- ✓ Follow the rules about handwashing and hygiene to help keep me and my friends safe (e.g. from coronavirus).
