FUN ACTIVITIES to HELP LEARN SPELLINGS



We all recognise that learning new spellings can be a bit tricky. Try the activities below as a change from the normal!

UPPER & lower	AIR WRITING
Write each of your spelling words out two times. Write in UPPERCASE the first time, and lower case the second time.	Write your words in the air with your finger and ask someone to read the words you write – then swap over! Can you tell them which word it is (without checking your list).
Curly Words First, write your words out in your normal best writing. Then, write them again in fancy curly letters.	MAGAZINE LETTERS Cut out letters from magazines or newspaper headlines and made your words as a collage.
Write your words out in pencil. Draw around your word (like a bubble) 5 more times using different coloured pencils.	ABC ORDER Write your words out in alphabetical order. Make each word BIGGER than the last. Then do it again, making each word smaller.
PYRAMID WRITING Write each of your words like a pyramid: s so som some	BE A POET Write an acrostic poem/rhyme using each letter of a word to start a new line. A - ants R - ride E - elephants
JOIN THE DOTS Write each of your words using dots. Then join the dots with a coloured pencil to make your word.	GET CREATIVE How else could you make your words? Out of sticks on an autumn walk; using your socks; or try making your spelling

words out of food... and then eat it!
