



FUN ACTIVITIES to HELP LEARN SPELLINGS

We all recognise that learning new spellings can be a bit tricky.
Try the activities below as a change from the normal !

<p><u>UPPER & lower</u></p> <p>Write each of your spelling words out two times.</p> <p>Write in UPPERCASE the first time, and lower case the second time.</p>	<p>AIR WRITING</p> <p>Write your words in the air with your finger and ask someone to read the words you write – then swap over! Can you tell them which word it is (without checking your list).</p>
<p><u>Curly Words</u></p> <p>First, write your words out in your normal best writing.</p> <p>Then, write them again in <i>fancy curly letters.</i></p>	<p>MAGAZINE LETTERS</p> <p>Cut out letters from magazines or newspaper headlines and made your words as a collage.</p>
<p>RAINBOW WORDS</p> <p>Write your words out in <i>pencil</i>.</p> <p>Draw around your word (like a bubble) 5 more times using different coloured pencils.</p>	<p>ABC ORDER</p> <p>Write your words out in alphabetical order.</p> <p>Make each word BIGGER than the last. Then do it again, making each word <i>smaller</i>.</p>
<p>PYRAMID WRITING</p> <p>Write each of your words like a pyramid:</p> <p style="text-align: center;">s so som some</p>	<p>BE A POET</p> <p>Write an <i>acrostic poem/rhyme</i> using each letter of a word to start a new line.</p> <p>A - ants R - ride E - elephants</p>
<p>JOIN THE DOTS...</p> <p>Write each of your words using dots.</p> <p>Then join the dots with a coloured pencil to make your word.</p>	<p>GET CREATIVE...</p> <p>How else could you make your words....?</p> <p>Out of sticks on an autumn walk; using your socks; or try making your spelling words out of food... and then eat it!</p>
